

Clothing Recycling for Residents in South Lyon, Walled Lake and Wixom

Residents in South Lyon, Walled Lake and Wixom can recycle unwanted clothing, shoes, accessories and other household discards such as kitchenware, tools, toys and books, with a free, residential curbside pickup service on the same day as your weekly, recycling pick-up service.

This service is provided by Simple Recycling and is an easy, free and convenient way to keep clothing and textiles out of the landfills.

Simple Recycling initially provides two collection bags to get residents started. Whenever residents use the Simple Recycling Collection bags and/or tags, the collecting driver will leave another bag for residents to use the next time. How to Recycle Clothing and Textiles at the Curbside:

- Step 1: Place clothing, shoes and small household items that you no longer need in the “Simple Recycling” bag provided or other waterproof bag with a tag or large label reading: “SIMPLE RECYCLING.”
- Step 2: Leave the bag(s) curbside on the same day you would leave your other recyclable materials out for collection. *Do **NOT** place clothing and textiles in your curbside bin or cart.*
- Step 3: Simple Recycling will collect the bags and recycle their contents for reuse!

This program is in addition to your current curbside recycling program. Your recycling cart / bin collection remains the same.

Acceptable Items Include:

- Clothing and Socks
- Bedding (sheets, pillows and cases, blankets, comforters) and Table Linens
- Belts, Hats and Ties
- Books
- Boots and Shoes
- Curtains/Draperies
- Fashion Accessories
- Halloween costumes
- Handbags & Purses
- Kitchenware
- Pet beds & clothing
- Stuffed Animals
- Tools
- Towels
- Toys
- Undergarments
