

Be a part of history

The Wixom Cemetery is located on the northwest corner of N. Wixom and W. Maple Roads in Wixom, Michigan.

The gently rolling landscape is enclosed with an iron fence and marked with a Victorian era arch. The grounds contain several family monuments, fieldstone headstones with various carvings, and granite markers, some of which date back to the 19th century.

The Wixom Cemetery originated as the South Commerce Burial Ground. In 1838, Wixom pioneer Alonzo Sibley (1810-1896) donated an acre of land for cemetery purposes immediately south of his home. Sibley was the first president of the future Village of Wixom as well as the first president of the Burial Society.

The cemetery has historical significance as the final resting place of Wixom's earliest pioneer settlers including Ahijah Wixom (1794-1855), after whom the Village took its name, and Reverend Samuel Wire (1786-1870), pastor of the First Free Will Baptist Church from 1853 to 1860. The nearby Wire House was Reverend Wire's family home and Wixom's first funeral home. The Wire House is still maintained as a historically significant location to this day.

On October 23, 1987 the South Commerce Burying Ground (Wixom Cemetery) was listed in the State Register of Historic Places as Michigan Historic Site No. 1464.

How to get a Columbarium niche

Purchase a columbarium niche at the Wixom Clerk's Office. Upon payment, a deed to a niche will be issued. A deed grants the right of interment, but the ownership of the columbarium remains with the City of Wixom. Niches may be transferred or inherited upon proper notification to the Clerk's office.

Engraving

Engraving of a columbarium niche cover must be in completed upon interment. Engraving also must be in compliance with the Cemetery's policy in terms of form, font, and size. Adhering plaques, flower vases, portraits, and other items is prohibited.

COLUMBARIUM

A columbarium is a structure for the respectful and usually public storage of funerary urns, holding cremated remains of the deceased.



A niche dimension is approximately 12" x 12" x 12" deep. The City of Wixom will allow two urns per niche as long as the dimensions of the urns do not exceed 10" x 10" x 10".

In addition to the columbarium, Wixom Cemetery also has traditional burial plots available.
